εὐθὺς “Immediately!” vs.6 – up till now it referenced something Jesus did or effected, but now how does Mark use this word?

Vs11 How does the confession of the demons differ from yours? (pg.24)

Vs14-19 What is surprising about the men Jesus called? (pg.24-25)  
How about our call?

**Opposed by family and foe**

**3:20-35**

vs21 Why do you think Jesus' family members would take him to task?

vs23-27 How does Jesus disarm the argument of the Pharisees?

Vs28-30 What warning does Jesus give and why?

Vs34-35

Was Jesus rejecting his own flesh and blood or trying to make a point? If the later, what was the point?

(Galatians 3:26-28; Third Article of the Creed "holy Christian church, the communion of saints")

What is this "will of God" Jesus references? Because if it's contingent on the way we keep the 10 Commandments, none of us would be considered his "mother and brothers and sisters". (John 3:16; 6:40)
